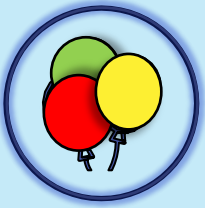

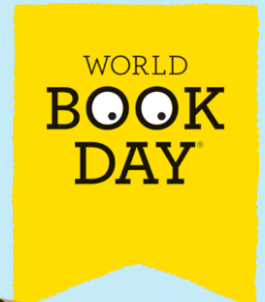
Next week we will be celebrating World Book day... All week!!
