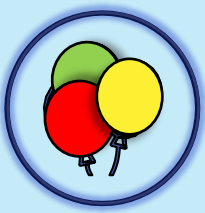

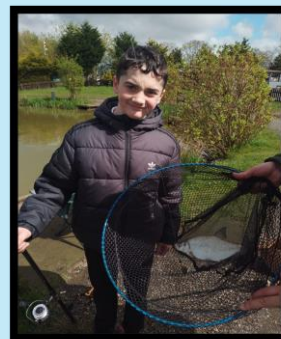


Stable Lives

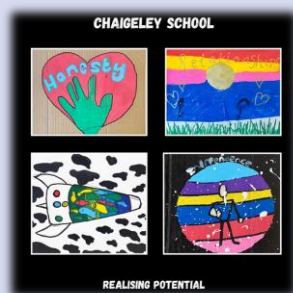
Fishing Trip
